- Entrants may use meat and ingredients of their choice. Chili must contain a minimum of 5 lbs. of meat.
- Recipes must be turned in the day of the cook-off; must include ingredients, cooking time, directions and temperature.
- Chili will be tested to the satisfaction of the judges and based on TASTE, APPEARANCE and the RECIPE (how easy to follow and prepare).
- Contestants can arrive and begin cooking at 10 AM.
- Judging begins at **1 PM**. Winner will be announced at **3 PM**.
- Contestants must be present to win.
- The Ladies Guild will sell bowls of chili, Frito pies, chili dogs, hot dogs, chips, drinks, and homemade cookies. The prices will be:

**Meal Deal:** Bowl of Chili, Frito Pie or Chili Dog, 2 cookies and drink - \$5

Bowl of Chili, Frito Pie, or Chili Dog - \$3 each      Hot Dog - \$2

Chips - \$1      Drinks - \$1      Cookies - 3 for \$1
